   Adam shared information that our school is now included in the Legacy of Schools Program and focus on reconcili-action in our school.

  - 5.1. By-Law Amendment Financial Year End Alignment (Amber)
     -Amber discusses how year end for CHEES is May 31 and for the casino fund is July 31 and we would like to amend the year end to both on July 31, Amber Motions, Jess seconds, everyone in favor APPROVED
  - 5.2. Motion to Accept Financial Statement from Past Year (Amber)
    General account started at \$12,00 last year- income is from fun lunch, and we ended with \$9,800. We are keen to spend the money earned in the year it is earned. We discussed how the ten dollar tickets were insufficient at the food truck event, so we may spend more on that in the future.

    Casino account has to be used on the approved list of spends. We spent just under \$50,000 over the last school year and we have about \$25,000 remaining, and we have more money coming in February/March 2025 from the December Casino. We have \$15,000 remaining in the geodome account. Balance needs to stay at least \$10,000.

    Amber is asking for two signatures to review the financial statement, Jeri-Lyn and Frederique. Jeri-lyn motions to accept the financial year end statements upon final review, Jess seconds, APPROVED

# 6. Principal Update (Adam)

#### 6.1. School Enrolment for 2024/2025

School enrolment is up, we expected a minimum of 321 and actual enrolment is currently 335. Projections for the year are about 350 for the year at the end of last school year. Our school is on a monitor list for utilization rate, and we are currently above 80%.

### 6.2. Class Configuration

We need to get to 350 to get additional funding for another classroom, which would be in Grade 5. Our funding numbers will need to be submitted tomorrow. Ms. Kwoang is working 0.2, focusing at least ½ in grade 5. Ms, Whitehead is using her support blocks and targeting the Grade 5 classes. Mr. Sager, who teaches French and works with the teachers and students on maximizing French proficiency. Lunchroom supervisors will also support the class with reading and supervision. Amber asks about our EAL learners and how we support them. Adam shares that we have a higher than average amount of EAL learners. Mr. K supports this in part of his time currently. School administrators met with our Area director and shared what is realistic as far as current standards based on funding. Focus on lowering the teacher to student ratio, particularly on the grade 5's.

## 6.3. Staffing Updates

Our Former music teacher has her leave extended until 2029, Ms. Whitehead is currently here in a temporary role, but expecting her to stay

for a large amount of time. Ms. Melnyk, her leave is extended until November with a possible extension. Ms. Berg in grade 4 is currently hired on a temporary basis and as it stands now, Mr. K will go into her current classroom if and when Ms. Melnyk returns. Rieko Templo is hired as a lunchroom supervisor and has been a great fit so far particularly in working with those with complex needs. Kathy Power, CBE lunchroom supervisor is coming in next week to offer insights and do some training. We currently have 7 lunchroom supervisors. Mr. Sager is shared with Branton, and is funded with special language initiative funding, and only teaches French to the 4, 5, and 6. The funding is currently year by year. We were the only school last year in the CBE to get this funding due to having the highest enrollment in late French immersion. Ms. Drever is new and teaching Grade 6, from another CBE school. Ms. Hoatra is working with us 15-30 hours a week as an EA and has a substitute EA working an additional 30 hours a week currently. Currently we have a few "elopers" in our grade 1 class that require support for safety. Student voice initiative began this week with a representative from each class.
